The **SGTeguhBersatu** Taskforce will harness the Malay/Muslim community's 'gotong royong' spirit by bringing together partner organisations to leverage their strengths and mobilise assets and resources to support those affected by COVID-19.

SUPPORT FOR THE RELIGIOUS SECTOR



For Asatizah

- Muis will work with mosques and Islamic Education Centres and Providers (IECPs) to ensure Asatizah remain relevant and earn an income by equipping them with skills to provide religious content online.
- Muis will work with Mendaki SENSE to provide structured training programmes for Asatizah to upskill, in line with the Asatizah Career and Competency Framework.
- Muis will work with agencies to help Asatizah apply for support schemes. These include:
 - Working with NTUC to encourage eligible ARS-certified Asatizah to tap on Self-Employed Person benefits.
 - Working with MSF to support affected Asatizah to apply for the Temporary Relief Fund.

For Mosques

- Muis is developing a platform to enable the community to make online donations to mosques through PayLah and GIRO.
- Muis will extend grants to mosques to provide parents a 50% waiver of aLIVE fees for 2 months.
- Muis will provide grants to support mosques to adopt the enhanced COVID-19 precautionary measures.

SUPPORT FOR COUPLES, FAMILIES & STUDENTS



For Couples & Families

- ROMM will waive payment for couples who wish to change their solemnisation dates.
- PPIS will work with MUIS, PERGAS and MHPA on initiatives to strengthen the psychological resilience of the community.

For Students

- MENDAKI will reopen its Tertiary Tuition Fee Subsidy (TTFS) application to students whose families' income are affected by COVID-19.
- MENDAKI will provide top up study loan assistance to students in the Institutes of Higher Learning (IHL) abroad. Priority will be given to final year students.
- MENDAKI will provide aid for students to procure digital devices for online learning.
- MENDAKI will provide financial aid of \$10 per school day to cover transport and meals for 3 months to ITE students who lost their part-time jobs.
- Mendaki SENSE will encourage graduating post-secondary and IHL students to take up SGUnited Traineeships.

SUPPORT FOR WORKERS & BUSINESSES



For Workers

- Mendaki SENSE will link job-seekers to growth sectors through Virtual Career Fairs and Helpline, CariKerja App and Kiosk, and SGUnited Jobs initiative.
- Mendaki SENSE will strengthen access to upskilling opportunities and training allowance.

For Businesses

- SMCCI will work with affected companies (e.g. events, tourism, retail, F&B sectors) to leverage wage offset, cashflow support and property tax rebate schemes.
- SMCCI will work with community volunteers on a central kitchen initiative that will provide cooked food to vulnerable groups during Ramadan.
